

West Destin Beach Restoration Project

2026 PROJECT OVERVIEW

\$10 Million Investment in Our Beaches

A beach restoration project is coming to West Destin to repair damages from Hurricane Sally. This effort is largely funded through federal disaster recovery assistance.

Project Funding

- 90% funded by FEMA
- 10% funded through Beach Restoration Reserves

PROJECT LOCATION

West Destin

From the Jetty to the east side of South Bay near the Gulf Condos

Please note: There is a small 'gap' within the project area where sand will not be placed.

PROJECT DETAILS

Total Sand Placement: 150,600 cubic yards

- Reach 1: 89,800 cubic yards
- Reach 2: 60,800 cubic yards

Contractor: Great Lakes Dredge & Dock

TIMELINE

- Mobilization: March 2026
- Dredging Begins: April 2026
- Completion: Before May 1, 2026

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Beaches will remain open and accessible to the public
- Small, temporary closures will occur only where sand is actively being placed
- Closures will shift as work progresses
