

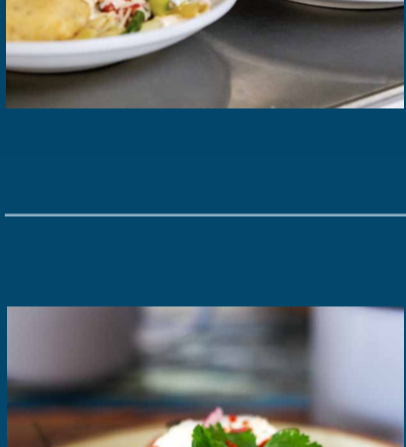

Grab-and-go bakery featuring pastries, desserts, quiches, and gluten-free items.

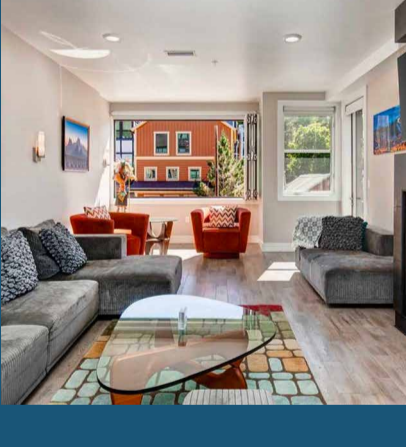

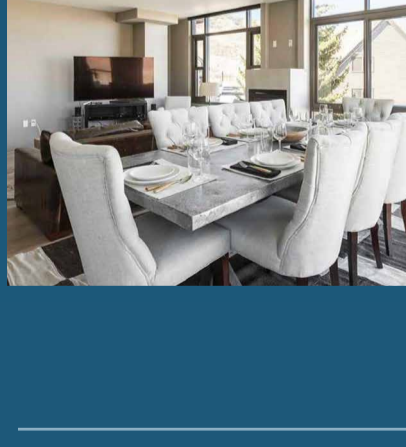
Non-profit farm offering farm-stand eats for pre-order.

6-bedroom condo with hot tub and private deck. Sleeps 12.



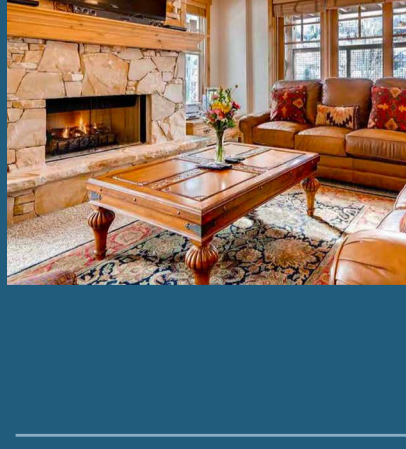
### Low301:

3-bedroom condo with gourmet chef's kitchen and stunning views. Sleeps 6.



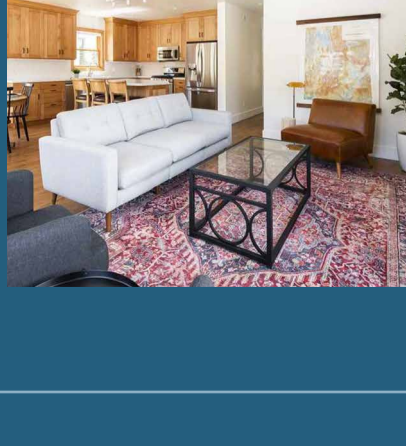
### Motherlode A:

4-bedroom condo with deck for dining. Sleeps 10.



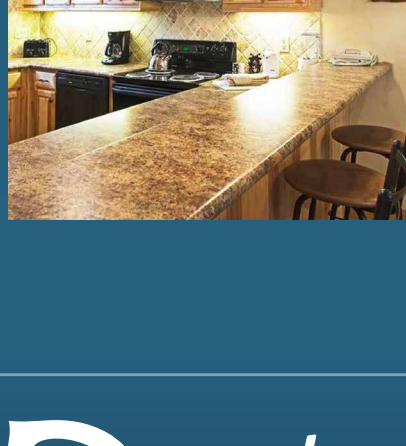
### Towne Pointe C201:
