# Top Snowshoe Trails in Park City



Park City is home to hundreds of miles of exceptional trails perfect for snowshoeing. You'll discover impeccably groomed trails, as well as wild ungroomed ones, which means there's a perfect trail for any skill level. Here are three of our favorites:



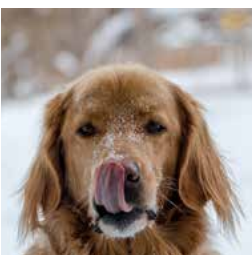
## Gambel Oak Loop

This trail is ideal for catching glimpses of wildlife and fantastic for first-time snowshoers. This moderate trail offers 629 feet of elevation gain with stunning views. The loop itself is just under four miles, making for a great, short day in the snow. Dogs are also allowed, as long as they are kept leashed. Trailhead is about one mile from the free bus system terminal on Main St.



## Round Valley

Northeast of Old Town, Round Valley boasts more than 700 acres of groomed trails. Visitors have their choice of five unique trailheads that crisscross the valley: Round Valley Way, Quinn's Junction, The Cove, Highland Drive, and Old Ranch Road. If you're looking to spend the day enjoying different terrains and scenery, this is the spot for you. Parking and restrooms are available.



## PC Hill

For a quick snowshoe experience, PC Hill Trail is an intermediate-level trail located in the heart of Park City. Only 1.3 miles long, the course offers a few challenging moments, plenty of stunning views of the mountain, and great opportunities to see the cityscape. If you feel like extending your snow trek, there are other trails to explore in the area. Dogs are allowed but must be kept on a leash.

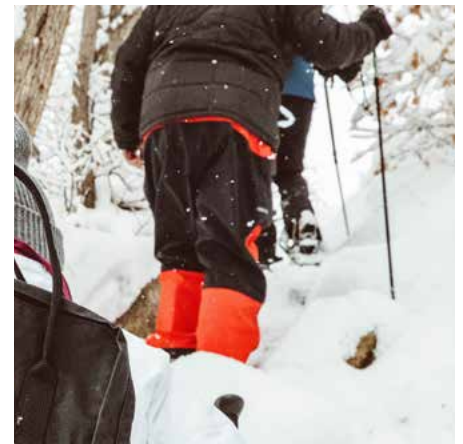
## Jans

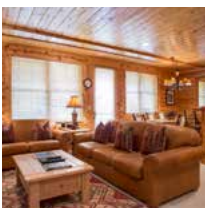
