Action-Packed Park City Water Activities

White Water Rafting

There are a plethora of Park City area rivers that promise grand rapids and spectacular wildlife viewing opportunities. For a more thrill-seeking day on the water, Weber River offers Class II rapids. Best Places to Stay in Park City with a Pool

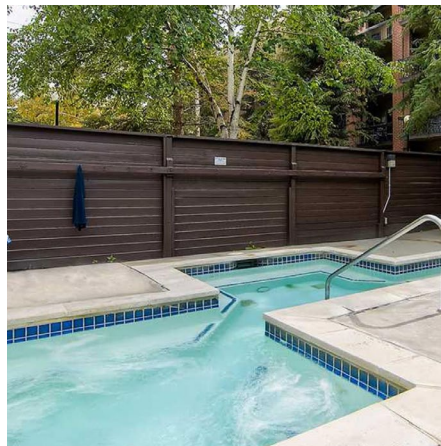

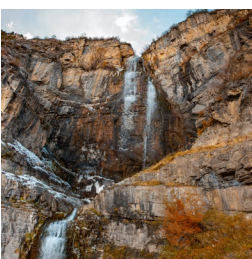
Picnic on the Beach

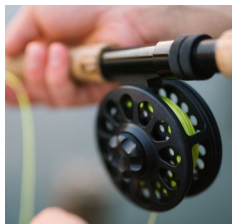
Horseback Ride to Stewart Falls

Park City's water adventure doesn't end at river rafting and dips in the lake. There are tons of ways to play in the water, check out the scenery, and get suited up for summertime fun!



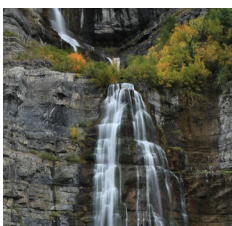
Shop Equipment Essentials at Jans:

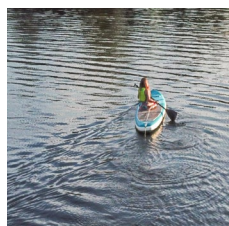
Deer Creek State Park and Reservoir:

Scenic state park in Heber offering windsurfing, fishing spots, and swimming.



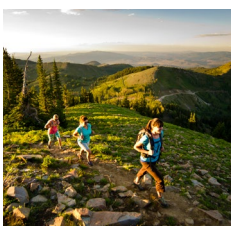
Bridal Veil Falls:

Four-mile hike offering alpine lake views and wildflower meadows.



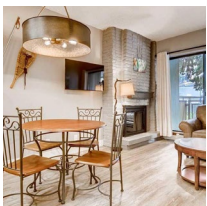

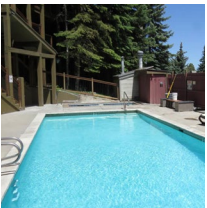

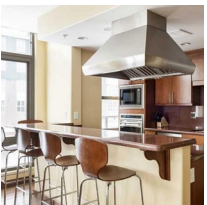
