Unforgettable Hot Springs on the Outskirts of Park City

If you're in search of a relaxing soaking experience just outside of Park City that will have you back in town for dinner reservations, visit one of these magical springs, all located within an hour-and-a-half of downtown.



Homestead Crater

A mere 18 miles from downtown Park City, this 65-foot deep, naturally formed geothermal hot spring allows visitors the options of tranquil soaking, one-of-a-kind scuba diving, or free-floating snorkeling. No matter which way you choose to enjoy the experience, you'll be wowed by warm waters and the 55-foot limestone dome that extends from the springs up to the sky.

Reservations are strongly encouraged. Pricing starts at \$15, depending on the day and type of experience.



Fifth Water Hot Springs

Fifth Water is a nature lover's dream, with crystal-blue pools, dramatic canyon formations, and serene moments. Access to the springs requires a strenuous hike, but the journey is just as lovely as the waters. Plan to bring your own towel, wear sturdy shoes, and definitely pack plenty of water and a lunch. Get there early in the morning to avoid crowds.



Inlet Park at Saratoga Hot Springs

If you're looking for a no-frills, shallow water hot spring with easy access and stunning scenery, Inlet Park is for you. Located at the gorgeous Utah Lake, this geothermal hot spring is rugged, with muddy bottoms and full-on sun. The water is impressively warm (up to 109 degrees) and the setting is restful. Pack any gear you need to enjoy your time: chairs, towels, blankets, water, and snacks. Don't forget to take any garbage back with you.

The hot springs are for public day use only.

Meadow Hot Springs

Utah prides itself on its hospitality, and Meadow Hot Springs is a prime example. This clear-water, natural spring is actually located on private property, but the owner welcomes respectful guests to luxuriate in the peaceful waters. Meadow Springs is truly an oasis, offering a deep pool to swim or scuba dive and fewer crowds than other main attractions.

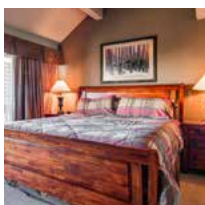
Snowcrest 205:
